



**Directive 2002/95/EC
Restriction of Hazardous Substances (RoHS)
Certificate of Compliance**

The European Union Directive 2002/95/EC Restriction of Hazardous Substances (RoHS) legislation restricts the use of certain substances in electrical and electronic equipment. This directive applies to all electrical or electronic products and their components placed on the market after July 1, 2006. The substances included in this directive and their maximum concentration values are provided below:

Banned Substances	Maximum Concentration Value*
Cadmium	0.01%
Hexavalent Chromium	0.1%
Lead	0.1%
Mercury	0.1%
Polybrominated Biphenyls (Mono - Deca)	0.1%
Polybrominated Diphenyl Ethers (Mono - Deca)	0.1%

*Baseline analytical testing was performed by SGS Hong Kong Ltd. on select products. All results were less than the maximum concentration values of the substances listed.
